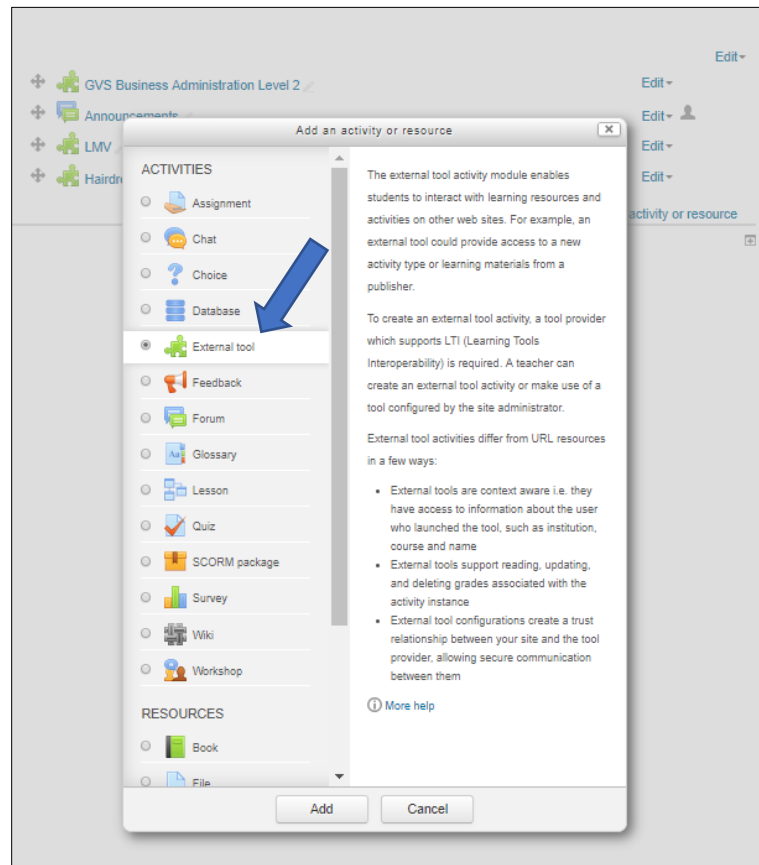




Setting up a GVS-LTI connection in Moodle

1. Within a relevant course in Moodle, turn editing on, click on the “Add an activity or resource” button and select “External Tool” from the list on the left.





2. You should fill out the fields in the form, using the settings supplied in your “GVS-LTI access” email as follows:

- “Activity name” – this is what your students will see as a link in Moodle, e.g. you could use “Construction Core Units Level 2”
- “External tool type” – leave as it is, “automatic, based on launch URL”
- “Launch URL” – enter <http://pilot.i-gvs.com/moodle/>
- “Launch container” – we suggest that you select the “New window” option, although the other options will also work
- Consumer key – from your setup email, e.g. “2465-gvs-training-i-gvs-com-395168-moodle”
- Shared secret – from your setup email, e.g. “Nb8xLJTWE@4g3y”
- Custom parameters – from your setup email, e.g. “course_id=2307”

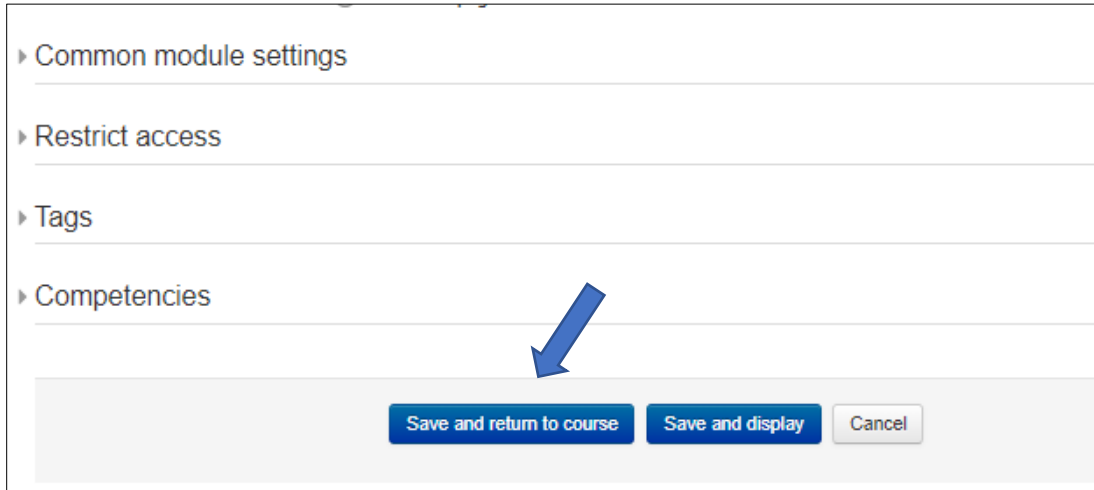

3. Under the “Privacy” section, make sure that all items are checked, except for “Accept grades from the tool”.
